Dayton/Miami Valley Senior Olympics Hall of Fame

Joan Borchers Kettering, Ohio Date of Birth – 1-19-25 Died – 3-08

She participated at the local level from 1982 to 1999 and won medals each year in her sport – table tennis. She participated in the Ohio Senior Olympics many years in Akron, Youngstown, Cincinnati, Columbus and Dayton and earned her way to the National Senior Games three times in 1993 (Baton Rouge), 1995 (San Antonio), and 1997 (Tucson). Her family has fond memories of traveling with her to the state and national events and seeing her excel in table tennis.

Allen Huff Dayton, Ohio Age 63

He has participated at the local level for several years in track events. His most recent accomplishments include winning a gold medal in the 400 m run and silver medals in the 100 and 200 m runs at the 2007 Dayton Area Senior Olympics. He also participated in the Southwest Ohio Senior Olympics and won gold medals in the 200 and 400 m runs and a silver medal in the 100m. In the Dayton Track Classic he placed first in the 400 m and second in the 100m. In the 2007 Ohio Senior Olympics he won gold medals in all three events – 100, 200 and 400m. He won his way to the 2005 National Senior Games in Pittsburgh and placed third in the 200m and fourth in the 400m run. He also participated in the 2007 Penn Relays where in the 4x400 his team received a silver medal.

Tom Johnson Dayton, Ohio Age 67

At the local level he won gold in four track events – the 50, 100, 200 and 400m races in the 2007 Dayton Area Senior Olympics. He also won two gold medals in the 100 and 200 m races and a silver medal in the 400m run in the Southwest Ohio Senior Olympics. He placed first in both the 100 and 200 in the Dayton Track Classic. At the 2006 Kentucky Senior Games, he received a gold medal in the 200m run and a silver medal in the 100m run. In the 2007 Ohio Senior Olympics he received gold medals in the 100, 200 and 400m races. At the 2007 National Senior Games in Louisville, he was a three time silver medalist in the 100 and 200m and the 4x100 relay. He also received a silver medal in the 2007 Penn Relays in the 100m run.

Carrie Jones Dayton, Ohio Age 73

She played with the Ohio Cardinals women's softball team for a ten year period on the local, state and national level. Her team won gold medals at the National Senior Games in 1991 at Syracuse, 1993 at Baton Rouge and 1995 in San Antonio and a silver medal in 1997 in Tucson. She also participated in shot put, discus and javelin and earned gold and silver medals. She was inducted into the State of Ohio Softball Hall of Fame in 1988.

Bob Lamb Centerville, Ohio Age 84

Since 1990 he has participated in swimming events at the local level and then in 2000 he starting competing at the state level. He swims free style, breast stroke and backstroke. At the 2005 National Senior Games in Pittsburgh he placed 7th in the 200 m backstroke event. In the 2007 National Senior Games in Louisville he placed 4th in the 200m breast
